CERTIFICATION

This is to certify that the remains of the late (name of deceased, sex, age), have been fully embalmed and are in a thoroughly sanitary condition for removal to (place of arrival,) Philippines.

This is to further certify that as indicated in the attached copy of Death Certificate / Certificate of Fact of Death, the deceased did not die of a contagious disease and that the remains to be shipped did not originate from a place contaminated by a contagious disease.

This is to further certify that the coffin contains nothing but only the remains of the late (name of deceased) together with the necessary clothing and packing. The coffin has been hermetically sealed in a zinc-lined container and then encased in a plywood shipping box with markings on the outside and addressed as follows:
