PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

I. Renewal of Passport

1. Latest Passport and photocopy of first page.
2. Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card and photocopy, for HK residents.
3. Personal appearance of applicant.

II. Minor Applicants (new/renewal/lost passport)

1. Report of Birth issued by the Philippine Consulate General, if born in Hong Kong; PSA-issued Birth Certificate, if born in the Philippines or in other countries; and photocopy.
2. Latest Passport and photocopy of first page.
3. Parents' Passports and photocopies of first page.
4. Parents' PSA-issued Marriage Certificate or Report of Marriage and photocopy. If not married, PSA-issued Birth Certificate of mother, Affidavit of Illegitimacy, Affidavit of Recognition and photocopies.
5. Personal appearance of minor, accompanied by either parent.
6. Additional requirements for lost passport:
 - a. Two (2) copies of Affidavit of Loss.
 - b. Original and photocopy of Police Report, HK Identification Card and School ID.
 - c. Data/biometrics/photo capture will be done after 15 clearing days.

III. Passport Application for Filipino Citizens under R.A. 9225

1. Latest Passport and photocopy of first page.
2. Reacquisition/Retention of Philippine Citizenship documents and photocopies.
3. Hong Kong Identity Card.
4. Personal appearance of applicant.

IV. Passport Application for Naturalized Filipinos

1. Latest Passport and photocopy of first page.
2. Birth Certificate and photocopy.
3. Certificate of Naturalization of applicant/parents, and photocopies.
4. Identification Certificate of Citizenship and photocopy.
5. Election of Philippine Citizenship and photocopy.
6. Hong Kong Identity Card.
7. Personal appearance of applicant.

V. Renewal of Mutilated Passport

1. Same as Renewal of Passport plus two (2) copies of Affidavit of Mutilation.
2. Personal appearance of applicant.
3. Data/biometrics/photo capture will be done on the next working day.

VI. Replacement of Lost Passport

1. Photocopy of lost passport. If none, PSA-issued Birth Certificate and photocopy.
2. PSA-issued Marriage Certificate or Report of Marriage and photocopy, if lost passport is under married name.
3. Two (2) copies of Affidavit of Loss.
4. Police Report and photocopy.
5. Photocopy of valid employment contract.
6. Hong Kong Identity Card and photocopy.
7. Letter from employer informing the Philippine Consulate General that he/she is aware that the passport of applicant is lost.
8. Personal appearance is required.
9. Data/biometrics/photo capture will be done after 15 clearing days.

TRAVEL DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS

1. Photocopy of expired/mutilated/lost passport.
2. Hong Kong Identity Card and photocopy.
3. Four (4) copies passport size photo with white background.
4. Copy of airline ticket.
5. Personal appearance of applicant.
6. Additional requirements:

In case of Expired/Mutilated Passport:

- a. Photocopy of valid employment contract.
- b. Photocopy of latest Hong Kong visa.
- c. Two (2) copies of Affidavit of Mutilation.

In case of Lost Passport:

- a. If copy of lost passport is not available, Report of Birth or PSA-issued Birth Certificate and photocopy.
- b. PSA-issued Marriage Certificate or Report of Marriage and photocopy, if lost passport is under married name.
- c. Two (2) copies of Affidavit of Loss.
- d. Police Report and photocopy.
- e. Any of the following: COMELEC, SSS, PhilHealth, Pag-ibig, OWWA Membership ID, LTO Driver's License, Professional Regulatory Commission ID, Unified Multipurpose ID, Postal ID, NBI Clearance, etc.

7. Travel Document will be issued on the next working day.

AMENDMENT OF PASSPORT

I. To adopt/use husband's surname

1. Report of Marriage issued by the Philippine Consulate General if married in Hong Kong, and photocopy. PSA-issued Marriage Certificate if married in the Philippines or in other countries, and photocopy.
2. PSA-issued Birth Certificate and photocopy.

II. To revert back to maiden surname

1. PSA-issued Birth Certificate and photocopy.
2. **For widows:**
 - a. PSA-issued Marriage Certificate and photocopy.
 - b. PSA-issued Death Certificate of husband and photocopy.

For annulled marriages:

- a. PSA-issued Marriage Certificate with annotations on the annulment, and photocopy.

For divorcees:

- a. PSA-issued Marriage Certificate with annotations that a Philippine Court has recognized the foreign divorce decree, and photocopy.

For divorce among Filipino Muslims:

- a. Divorce Decree from Shariah Court and photocopy.
- b. Joint Affidavit executed by two Imams who witnessed the divorce declaration.

NOTE: The Consulate reserves the right to require additional documents deemed necessary.

PHOTO CAPTURING REQUIREMENTS

- Wear decent attire, with collar and sleeves.
- Use of contact lenses for medical reasons is accepted, provided that the contact lenses do not change the applicant's true eye color.
- Wearing of veil is accepted for religious or medical reasons.
- Earrings, nose rings, necklaces and hair accessories should be removed prior to photo capturing.
- Frizzy/Afro hairstyles should be neatly arranged to show full frontal facial image.
