

REQUIREMENTS FOR 13(A) NON-QUOTA IMMIGRANT VISA (FOREIGN SPOUSE/CHILDREN OF A FILIPINO NATIONAL)

A. ORIGINAL AND PHOTOCOPIES REQUIRED

Three (3) sets (one (1) set original and two (2) sets photocopies) of the following documents:

1. Duly accomplished 13(a) Visa Application Form
2. Apostilled birth certificate of the visa applicant
3. Birth certificate of the Filipino spouse issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)
4. Marriage Contract (PSA-issued or Certified True Copy of the Report of Marriage at the Philippine Consulate General in Hong Kong or Authenticated in the Philippine Foreign Service Post where the couple was married)
5. Valid Philippine passport of Filipino spouse
6. Valid passport of the visa applicant (the passport must be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the intended period of stay in the Philippines)
7. Hong Kong ID of the visa applicant and his/her Filipino spouse
8. 2 x 2 colored photographs of the visa applicant in plain white background for each set of documents
9. Proof of financial capacity (i.e. latest six (6) months bank statements, income tax return, proof of property ownership, employment contract and/or employment certificate, pension or similar documents)
10. Divorce decree or dissolution of marriage (if applicable)
11. Birth certificate of unmarried children below twenty-one (21) years of age at the time of application (if applicable)
12. Apostilled Certificate of No Criminal Conviction (Please refer to Section B for relevant information)
13. Apostilled medical certificate and medical records (Please refer to Section C for relevant information)

B. HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF NO CRIMINAL CONVICTION (HONG KONG POLICE CLEARANCE)

1. Duly accomplished [request for letter endorsement](#) to the Hong Kong Police Authority
2. The Consulate's Visa Section will draft an endorsement letter to the Hong Kong Police Authority requesting for a Hong Kong Certificate of No Criminal Conviction (HK CNCC) for the visa applicant
3. The visa applicant shall submit the letter to the Hong Kong Police Authority
4. The original HK CNCC will be forwarded by the Hong Kong Police Authority to the Consulate within a period of four (4) calendar weeks
5. The visa applicant shall collect the certificate from the Consulate (Window 9) and bring the same to the Hong Kong High Court to be apostilled

C. MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

1. Duly accomplished MFA Form No. 11
2. The medical certificate which includes the original laboratory tests and x-ray plates should be authenticated by a Notary Public or the Home Affairs Department of Hong Kong
3. The document/s must be apostilled by the Hong Kong High Court before submission to the Consulate

Processing fees and time: HKD 1,200 (Three (3) working days)

HKD 1,400 (Two (2) working days)

IMPORTANT:

- Personal appearance of the visa applicant AND his/her Filipino spouse is required upon submission of the documentary requirements to the Consulate.
- The Visa Officer may require other supporting documents from the visa applicant depending on the evaluation of the application.
- The apostilled CNCC and Medical Certificate/Report should be valid for at least six (6) months at the time of submission of the documents to the Bureau of Immigration in the Philippines.
- The Visa Section (Window 9) accepts applications from Monday to Thursday (except PH and HK public holidays), between 9 A.M. to 2 P.M.
- Upon issuance of the visa by the Consulate, the applicant must then proceed to the Bureau of Immigration in the Philippines to continue the application process upon his/her arrival in the country.
- The visa applicant must stay in the Philippines until the application process at the Bureau of Immigration is complete which can take six (6) months or more.
- Issuance of the 13(a) Non-Quota Immigrant Visa is based on the principle of reciprocity. Please always check beforehand if the applicant is qualified to obtain the said visa before filing the application.

IMPORTANT:

- Accomplish this form and attach a copy of your valid passport and Hong Kong ID.
- Submit the duly accomplished form to the Visa Window (Window 9), Monday to Thursday, except PH and HK public holidays, between 9 am to 4 pm.
- The Consulate will draft the endorsement letter for the Hong Kong Police Authority and release the same on the next working day.
- The Consulate's endorsement letter is valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance.
- The applicant shall bring the endorsement letter to the Hong Kong Police Headquarters.
- The original HK CNCC will then be forwarded to the Philippine Consulate General within four (4) calendar weeks. If no update is received from the Consulate, kindly send an e- mail to **hongkongpcg.visa@dfa.gov.ph** to follow up on the status of your request.
- The applicant shall collect the original HK CNCC from the Visa Window (Window 9), Monday to Thursday, except PH and HK public holidays, between 9am to 4pm.
- The applicant shall bring the original HK CNCC to the High Court of Hong Kong for apostille.
