9(a-3) Visa for Medical Treatment Visitors

Kindly prepare the documents in the following order. Please do not staple the printed documents, paper clips may be used to keep the documents in order.

- Printed copy of the duly filled-out visa application form with passport size photo taken within the last six (6) months with plain white background
- Original and photocopy of passport valid for at least six (6) months beyond the authorized period of stay
- Original and photocopy of Hong Kong Identification Card (HKID)
- Tickets or flight reservation (entry and exit)
- Acceptance letter or confirmation of treatment or appointment from a Philippine medical or wellness institution
- Proof of medical condition, such as medical abstract from the sending medical or wellness institution

Proof of financial capacity:

- Bank statement of the latest six (6) months reflecting the deposits and withdrawals and with a minimum maintaining balance of HKD 20,000 (mandatory requirement)
- Pay slips for the latest six (6) months or employment certificate with remuneration (for employees)
- Pension statements of the latest six (6) months (for retirees)
- Receipt/confirmation of advance payment or deposit made for the treatment
- Letter of Guarantee from the sponsor with proof of financial capacity
- Health insurance policy (if any)
- Hotel accommodation or proof of lodging
- Letter of permission from a parent/guardian for minors not traveling with a parent/guardian

For escort:

 Letter from the sending medical or wellness institution assigning the foreign national to escort the patient

IMPORTANT:

- Personal appearance of the applicant is required for the submission of the documents.
- The Visa Officer may require other supporting documents from the applicant depending on the evaluation of the visa application. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- All documents in any foreign language must be submitted with English translation.
- Some cases require an authority from the Department of Foreign Affairs of the Philippines in Manila
 prior to the issuance of a visa. In such cases, the processing time will take 7 to 10 business days upon
 receipt of the applicant's printed documents.
- Foreign nationals with no nationality indicated on their passport must submit a visa application at least two (2) months before their intended date of travel to the Philippines

since prior approval from the Department of Foreign Affairs of the Philippines in Manila is required before a visa can be issued. Please do not purchase airline tickets unless and until the visa has been approved. Flight reservations may be submitted in lieu of a confirmed flight booking when submitting the documents to the Consulate.
